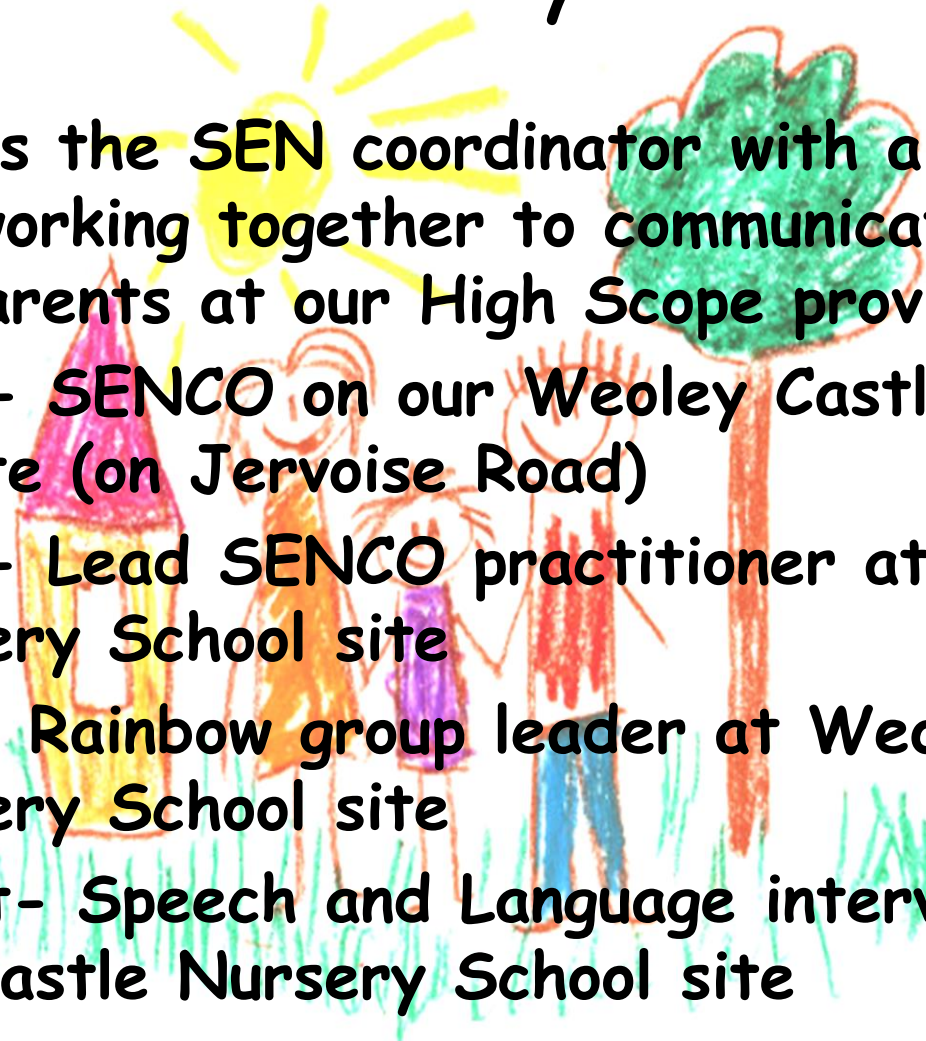


Special Educational Needs children at Weoley Castle Nursery?

Communication & Training in Weoley Castle Nursery



Communication

- We openly talk with all parents about their children and possible needs or concerns they may have
- Every child has a key worker who is happy to talk with their children's parents every day
- Every parent is involved in the plans made for their child and works together with us in line with the SEN code of practice

Training

- All our staff have been High Scope trained and Nurture trained
- We have qualified teachers leading the SEN curriculum across all sites for our 2, 3 and 4 year olds
- Members of our SEN team are Autism trained

Strategies we use at Weoley Castle Nursery

Educational Psychologists- Observe, assess and make recommendations to help us and support your child's development

CAT team- Communication and Autism team work with us to help us with training and understanding in this area

- We work in small groups, with a key worker for each child and a colour group
- We use visual time tables, now and next boards, Wellcomm language programme, Speech and language intervention groups all within our daily routine, so every child knows what will happen every day
- If we need more support with a child we use other agencies such as speech and language therapists, health visitors, Child development centres, Educational Psychologists through a referral system
