

Goldilocks and the Three Bears





Toddle Waddle





Phonics focus - environmental sounds and rhythm/tempo. Listening and remembering sounds.

Home—Oxfam





Maths focus - talk about shapes and comparisons of size, length, height, capacity and shape language such as corners, round, square.

Children settling in, focus upon family, understanding similarities and differences in families compared to own, diversity.





Stick Man





Rhymes/Poems

Rhythm, repetition; memory and emotions. Environmental sounds, adventure, journey, order and sequencing. Positional language, under/over.

Phonics focus - rhythm and rhyme, environmental and instrumental sound discrimination, body percussion.

Non Fiction





The Gruffalo





Phonics focus - rhythm and rhyme. Exploring speech sounds and discrimination between different sounds and voice sounds.

Tells story of how families celebrate Chinese New Year; simple words and illustrations; new vocabulary, diversity and different cultures.





Hippo has a Hat





How Does An Egg Hatch?




Reading for information, life cycles and new life, growth, respect and care for living things. Links to other core books.




Poem - Oh Dear by Michael Rosen

Growth, life cycle of a plant, caring for a plant and weather. Nature and how things work. Opportunity for children to make links with Jack and the Beanstalk and explore further.




To support children with the transition to school, clear and engaging language and illustrations. Relatable and depicts positive experiences of starting school and being in the wider world.

Hey, Water




